




'Transitions' Leadership Program - 2012



Program approach

The program provides opportunities for you to think about organisational systems and group dynamics and explore your own experiences of leadership, management and role transitions.

Together, we create a powerful learning space where you can access new understandings about your work roles and contribute to transformation – your own and your organisation's.

The program uses a range of methods with a focus on experiential and action learning. In each session you'll be encouraged to reflect on your own experiences, interact with others, consider readings and other input - and then try out new approaches to your work. It offers a model where:

- you can apply your learning by exploring issues relating to your work roles**
 - your experience is honoured**
 - people take responsibility for their own learning**
 - we develop shared trust and maintain confidentiality boundaries**

Consultants take joint responsibility for structuring and consulting to each seminar session, providing reading and theoretical overviews and supporting the exploration of individual and group experience.
